


What CEU microcredentials are there?

CEU microcredentials are structured within an ecosystem that includes all the competencies that can be acquired and recognized during undergraduate and postgraduate studies. The microcredentials are divided into: Las microcreenciales se dividen en:

- **21st-century skills**, divided into six areas, and applicable to all bachelor's degree programmes.
- **Learning pathways composed of microcredentials and embedded into bachelor's degree programmes:** Oral Communication for Law and Political Science students at CEU UCH's Alfara del Patriarca Campus.

Ethical commitment

Competencies concerning social awareness, civic responsibility and sensitivity to the environment.



Research

These competencies concern the application of the scientific method in a specific area, contributing to the progress of society.



Instrumental competencies

These are value-added competencies concerning the effective use of information resources, digital skills, and the ability to speak foreign languages.



Internationalization

These are the competencies needed to operate effectively in today's globalized workplace.



Soft Skills

These personal skills go beyond mere knowledge and information: they concern the knowhow which all top professionals possess.
