





The international study program with Dayton University is a Master's Degree in Law.

The online LL.M. Program, thanks to its network of international contacts, helps those lawyers who decide to take the bar exam to practice law in some U.S. states. The program allows its students to serve in global entities based in Spain and the USA that work with foreign countries or in entities based in any other country in the world that have interests and operate in Spain and the USA.

WHAT IS IT ABOUT?

It consists of 30 credits that are developed over 12 online courses divided into subjects focused on the bar exam: Professional Responsibility, Business Relations, Evidence, Real Estate, Civil Crimes, Inheritance and Wills, Civil Procedure, Constitutional Law, Criminal Law and Procedure, and Contracts of Sale and Purchase.

Although the courses are offered 100% online and asynchronously, the professors are in direct contact with the students through tutorials and platforms such as Zoom.

The 12 courses will be given during three semesters starting in January, May and August.
