This master program focuses on customer and business relationships/branding and explains the perfect conditions in which marketing decisions and strategies can take place. With this program you will improve your understanding of the customer and your relationships with companies.

WHAT IS IT ABOUT?

This is a two-year master's program. Upon graduation you will obtain a Master's degree from the University of Economics in Katowice (Poland), the University of Bergamo (Italy), the University of Applied Sciences in Aschaffenburg (Germany) and a Master's degree from the CEU Cardenal Herrera University (Spain).

To ensure the best quality, monitoring and evaluation of the project, the following organizational scheme with organizational bodies is adopted:

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent (at least 6 semesters and 180 ECTS).
- Proof of proficiency in English at a minimum level B2 of the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).
- Good academic record.
